## Order of Play – Non-Challenge Courts

### How to determine Order of Play on Non-Challenge courts when they are full?

During those busy times when the courts are full, we use a white board system to manage the order of play.

- A separate whiteboard will control each playing side (east & west)
  - **Once all the Non-Challenge courts on a given side of the facility are in use and people are waiting to play, you must sign onto the whiteboard in order to play.**
- If a foursome wishes to continue playing together, they may do so, but after finishing a game, they must:
  - exit the court
  - place their names on the board in the first available open cell, and they cannot return to the courts until their cell is “next.”
